GOD'S DESIGN OF THE WOMAN'S BODY

 - e. When Adam awoke and saw Eve he recognized the difference and said, “This is now bone of my bones, and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman (ish shah) because she was taken out of Man (ish).” Genesis 2:23. This is where _____ was clearly established.
